

Besides its function as a data collector and data keeper, MaSiH has the capacity to give real-time data analysis.







ZERO SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PROGRAM

From 16th October 2023, no plastic bags are allowed on HASA's premises on Mondays



Malaysia produces about 14 million tons of garbage a year with 43.7% of it being dry goods that can be recycled such as plastic, glass, iron and tetra pack.

Use of food plastic packaging in Malaysia is estimated to reach a whooping 148,000 metric tons in 2020 alone!²
