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
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#### USER ACCESS CONTROL POLICY (UACP)

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

An Electronic Medical Record (EMR) is digitally documented information about the health of an identifiable individual, recorded by a doctor or other healthcare professionals. It contains history, physical examination, investigations, diagnosis, treatment and other sensitive data that is needed to ensure continuity of care for the patient among healthcare providers. The patient has the right to expect that there will be no disclosure of all or any of the information to persons without the patient-provider relationship unless he/she gives permission. Therefore, there is a responsibility on the part of custodians and users of the medical record to ensure that confidentiality of medical records is maintained at all times. This is done by having a clear User Access Control Matrix.

#### 1.1 Background of UniMEDS

As the healthcare industry is constantly evolving and profoundly growing, the technology too was impacted as the conventional paper-based medical records are no longer relevant and incapable to manage the large amount of patient data day by day. In spite of that, this conventional method has been replaced with Open Electronic Medical Records (OpenEMR), with the aim to facilitate and smoothen the health facility business operations. The implementation of the EMR is designed not only to provide patient's medical histories, and patient's information but also to expedite the processing time to access their health information.

With the innovation to improve the current system, a dedicated team of system developers from Information Technology, UiTM Sg Buloh Campus, has been formed and responsible to design the new hospital operating system. Hence, in the year of 2015, the OpenEMR has been rebranded to a more efficient hospital operating system called University Medical System (UniMEDS). UniMEDS which is currently executed at PPUiTM Sg. Buloh has been enhanced with featured modules which cover inpatient management, clinic's appointment schedule, order management, clinical documentation, pharmacy and so forth.

In 2017, management has decided to expand the UniMEDS's service to be executed at another UiTM's health facility which is PPUiTM Selayang. Throughout this period, an integration using HL7 has been adopted for seamless communication and exchange of electronics health information. This integration helped streamline the data sharing of radiological imaging and laboratory results and increased the efficiency in the delivery of healthcare services within the organization.

In 2020, UniMEDS made significant progress by developing and deploying its own mobile application, representing UniMEDS's dedication towards user's experience. The mobile apps aimed to bridge the gap between patients and healthcare providers, fostering better communication, improved accessibility, and ultimately, more efficient and personalized care.

Continuing the momentum, in 2021, UiTM Puncak Alam achieved another significant milestone by inaugurating its distinguished healthcare facilities known as Hospital Al-Sultan UiTM Puncak Alam (HASA). To bolster the healthcare services provided at HASA, both UniMEDS and its corresponding mobile application have been effectively implemented and deployed. Since then and up to the present, UniMEDS has been consistently updating its platform to ensure the delivery of the best possible services for patients.

#### 2.0 PURPOSE OF USER ACCESS CONTROL POLICY

The purpose of the user access control policy is defined as per following:

- To determine the level of access and permissions granted to each user.
- To maintain the confidentiality of electronic patient information.
- To enforce user access control policy and ensure adherence to rules and regulatory compliance.
- Serves as a written statement and guidance for all levels of users outlining their access rights in order to prevent unauthorized individuals from viewing, modifying, or sharing sensitive data.

#### 3.0 SCOPE AND CONTEXT OF USER ACCESS CONTROL

This policy applies to all individuals who are given access to the Hospital Information System, including Clinical/Medical staff, Clinical Support staff, Postgraduate students (which directly treat patients), and any appointed administrative and financial staff.

The reason for access can be any or all data management processes including

- Generate
- Capture
- View
- Retrieve
- Store/ save
- Transfer/ export
- Analyze
- Copy
- Printing

#### 4.0 TYPE OF INFORMATION

This policy addresses information about a single patient as well as the group of patients cared for in HASA.

#### 4.1 Individual patient data


The main bulk of the data is data that makes up the Electronic Medical Record (EMR). The EMR contains information pertaining to a patient's health and illness and its management. The scope of information covered by this policy also encompasses other data regarding the patient that is obtained in order to facilitate the provision of patient care services including data regarding identity, demographics, payment methods and data required for communications. Summaries and medical reports are also individual patient data.

#### 4.2 Aggregated patient data

Data of a group of patients when put together is termed as aggregated data and is also subject to user access control. These data include:

- Registries
- Extracted and analyzed clinical data
- Reports prepared for external agencies
- Prevalence and incidence of diseases
- Utilization review information for example: Bed occupancy Rate(BOR) and length of stay (LOS)

#### 6.0 MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF USER ACCESS CONTROL

#### 6.1 Categorization of users

Patient data is used not only by care providers but also other professionals. Users of the EMR belong to two categories:

No.	Users	Type of User	Purpose of access
1	Primary users	Clinical	Use for purposes of managing the patient's health and disease
2	Secondary users	i) Clinical Support ii) Non- Clinical	Use of data of one or more patients for purposes other than managing the patient's current health problem

#### 6.2 User responsibility

- Individual staff shall keep their personalized user access ID and password confidential and use them to log into the system to access the modules permitted in their job functions.
- ii. It is the responsibility of the staff to access only to EMR of patients who are under their care. Any attempt to access another patient's EMR to obtain information without a legitimate reason is considered "snooping" in which make up an act of breaching patient's confidentiality and privacy.

#### 6.3 User Access Request

- i. The system used across departments, must obtain written permission from the Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM Management/Committee.
- ii. The system used by certain departments only must obtain written permission from the Head of Department.
- iii. User Accounts are only created for staff who are directly involved with the work process.
- iv. Special privileges must be obtained with the permission and approval of the Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM Management/Committee.

- v. Special access rights are granted only after approval and must be withdrawn after the related tasks are completed.
- vi. Clinical system access rights are limited to staff working at Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM only, unless obtaining clear written approval from the Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM Management/Committee.

#### 6.4 User identification and authentication

- The user account created must be unique and in accordance with the standards set at the UiTM level and easily recognizable based on the username.
- ii. Special access rights may not be granted until approval is given and must be revoked after the related tasks are completed.
- iii. Users are responsible for the account as soon as confirmation of acceptance is made.
- iv. Sharing accounts among users is prohibited. The account holder will be held liable in the event of a breach of the rules arising from the sharing of the account.
- v. Account ownership is not a person's absolute right and it is subject to UiTM rules. Accounts can be withdrawn if they violate the rules.
- vi. ICT System Administrator may freeze and terminate the account for the following reasons: -
  - Transfer of work areas
  - Transfer to another agency.
  - Retirement
  - Terminated of service
- vii. Clinical systems such as HIS, PhIS, LIS, PACS and Billing have additional conditions for user accounts as the system information is confidential and may be exposed to medico legal.
- viii. Limit system access to five (5) attempts. If it fails, system will prompt message to reset password.

#### 6.5 Password management

- Users must memorize and keep their passwords secret. Users are prohibited from writing/recording passwords in any media to avoid being known and misused by others.
- ii. Passwords must be changed at least once every 6 months
- iii. The minimum password length is 6 characters which consist of a combination of uppercase, lowercase, numbers, and special characters.
- iv. Inform the Head of Infostructure Department, Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM, if the password is compromised or suspected of being compromised. Change your existing password immediately.
- v. Passwords should not be displayed during input, in reports or other media and should not be encoded in the program.
- vi. Avoid to reuse the current passwords or last previous password.

### 6.6 Data management

- Users are not allowed to access unrelated data without permission.
- ii. Users of the application system must maintain the integrity of the information and do not share it with unrelated parties.
- iii. Information from the system cannot be taken out from Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM either in physical or digital form except with the approval of the Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM Management / Committee.
- iv. Applicants need to fill out form for a data request which is involved with patient information.
- v. The form must be complete with the required patient data information with the approval of the Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah UiTM Management / Committee.
- vi. The owner and user of the system is responsible for the data quality of the system being used.

#### 6.7 Audit Trail

The system is inclusive of an audit trail feature that will be performed by the system administrator. Audit tracks record the activities that take place in the system in chronological order and to allow inspection and reconstruction to be conducted. The audit trail contains the following information:

- Records of each transaction activity.
- Audit trail information contains staff identity, resources used, information changes, dates and times of activities, networks and applications used.
- · Staff access activities on the system either legally or otherwise.
- Information of abnormal system activity or activity that does not have security features.
- The system administrator shall review the audit trail records from time to time and prepare reports if necessary. This will be able to help detect abnormal activity earlier.
- Audit tracks should also be protected from unauthorized damage, loss, deletion, forgery and modification.

#### 7.0 GRADES OF CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA

Due consideration given to the degree of confidentiality of medical information and certain additional precautions may be taken to safeguard their confidentiality. The following are considered as **highly confidential data**:

- i. Data of medico-legal cases (murder, rape, assault, child abuse, drug abuse, litigation against a care provider or the institution)
- Data of patients with certain diseases, for example STD, Psychiatric conditions, HIV infection and AIDS
- iii. Data of persons which might be of public interest.
- iv. Data of patients if known to others may cause embarrassment or harm to him/her

#### 7.1 Information safety, security and confidentiality

- All information related to an individual patient shall be treated as private and confidential. Only authorized personnel are allowed access to patient information within the context of their roles and job functions on "Need to Know" basis.
- ii. Access to contents of Patient Records in hard copy or EMR format shall only be allowed when a visit is opened or upon receipt of a request by authorized

- personnel for administrative purposes. For more detail on access to EMR, please refer to GHOP HUiTM 4.10.5 General conditions for access of Electronic Medical Record in a facility.
- iii. The doctors who no longer serve with HASA are not allowed to access patient medical records. If they need to access patient records, approval from the Hospital Director is required.
