Former Vice-Chancellor's visit to the Selayang Campus UiTM

25th February – Prof. Emeritus Datuk Ir. Dr. Mohd Azraai Kassim, the former Vice-Chancellor of UiTM, visited Selayang UiTM Campus for the first time.

Renowned for its primary care services (PCM), PPUiTM Selayang is now venturing into something exciting with the provision of dialysis services as well as the establishment of a clinical simulation centre.

PCM clinics operate from 8 am to 5 pm on Mondays to Thursdays, while on Fridays the clinics start from 8 am to 12.15 pm and recommence at 2.45 pm to 5 pm. Among the services provided by the Primary care clinics include emergency/walk-in services, follow up for non-communicable diseases, Adolescent Health, INR monitoring, smoking cessation, and Staff & Student clinics. The clinics are currently operated by 18 Family Medicine Specialists and around 20 postgraduate students in the Masters of Family Medicine Programme.

The Dialysis Unit at PPUiTM Selayang started its operation on the 8th of October 2020 with a total of 10 dialysis machines. In conjunction with the visit, Prof. Emeritus Datuk Ir. Dr. Mohd Azraai Kassim officiated the PUiTM Selayang Haemodialysis Unit. Prof. Dato' Dr. Abu Bakar Abdul Majeed (Former Rector of UiTM Selangor), Prof. Dr. Mohd Zamrin Dimon (Dean of the Faculty of Medicine) and Prof. Dr. Sazzli Shahlan Kasim (Director of UiTM Hospital) were also present.


The Clinical Simulation Centre offers a simulated environment to enhance clinical skills and foster independent learning by utilising state-of-the-art technologies and manikins. The clinical modules available are Focused Skills Station (FSS), Critical Care Area, Virtual Reality (VR) lab and Ward Simulation modules. These modules do not only train our undergraduate students in preparation for clinical work but also provide advanced training for postgraduate students to enhance their clinical skills.

Overall, the visit has offered deep insight into the staff and students' experience on the campus.

Hospital UiTM Puncak Alam Handover Ceremony

23rd March – This day marked the symbolic handing over of the mock key to Hospital UiTM Puncak Alam from the concession company TRIpIc Medical Sdn. Bhd. to the Ministry of Higher Education & Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) in the presence of YB Datuk Seri Dr. Noraini Ahmad, Minister of Higher Education.

Also present were Datuk Seri Mazlan Yusoff (Secretary General), YB Dato' Mansor bin Haji Othman (Deputy Minister of MoHE), Tan Sri Rozali Ismail (Director of TRIpIc), Professor Emeritus Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr. Ibrahim Shah Abu Shah (Chairman of Board of Directors, UiTM), Prof. Ts Dr. Hajah Roziah Mohd Janor (Deputy Vice-Chancellor [Academic and International], performing duties as Vice-Chancellor).

A contractual agreement between MoHE, UiTM and TRIpIc Medical Sdn Bhd was signed on the 18th of February 2016 and construction commenced on the 11th of April 2017. The project comprises of a 400-bed teaching hospital, an academic building and an accommodation hall for nurses and housemen.

Following the key handover, the MoHE delegates were invited to have a tour of the hospital. Among the places visited by the delegates were the specialist clinics, rehabilitation centre, ambulatory daycare and the daycare operating theatres.
